TUITION INFORMATION Tuition payment is due in full upon registration. For a family that has multiple children enrolled, a 10% discount will apply on the lesser tuition of the second and any additional siblings (does not apply to monthly students). Please call the office to inquire about the specific cost of each session. Tuition varies by the number of weeks in the session and will appear on the registration form after class is chosen.

REFUND POLICY Refunds are given before the first Monday of the start of the session. All registrations are non-transferable. The annual registration fee is non-refundable. Registration fee is effective September through August. For the Summer Session refunds will not be given after June 1st. All summer camps, school vacation camps and special events are non refundable and cannot be transferred.

REGISTRATION FEE There is a non-refundable \$25 registration fee for the 2019-2020 season. Maximum fee per family is \$40. The registration fee is good for the academic year (September – August) For Summer Classes and Camps the registration is discounted to \$15 for any student who has not been enrolled in the academic year. Maximum per family \$25.
